Instructions

1. Outline your hand(s) on a piece of construction paper.
2. Cut around the outline of your hand(s).
3. Get creative and decorate your bird.
4. Completed birds should be placed in the "Bird's Nest" located at the Library's Info Desk.

After dropping off your bird be sure to fly by the Kids' section to browse the Bird Books display.
