Port Moody City Hall, Library, and the Recreation Complex are closed, Monday, November 11 in observance of Remembrance Day.

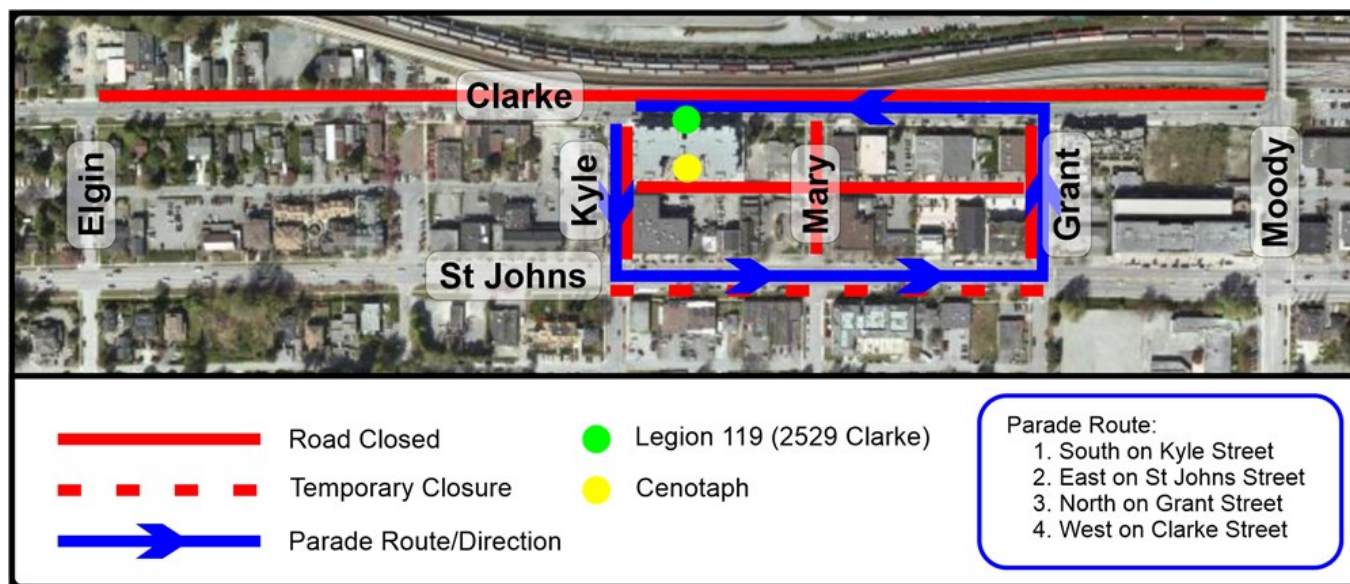

### 2024 Remembrance Day Ceremonies

- Parade March: 10:35 am (Parade route - Kyle St, St Johns St, Grant St, Clarke St)
- Ceremony/Service: following the parade, in front of the Legion on Clarke St (Wreath laying - Cenotaph on Spring St)

This year the Remembrance Day Parade route will muster along Clarke and Kyle Streets, adjacent to the Port Moody Legion at 2529 Clarke St. The parade will start south on Kyle St to St Johns St, east on St Johns St to Grant St, north on Grant St to Clarke St, then west on Clarke St, stopping in front of the Legion.

St. Johns St. will only be closed during the parade procession (approximately 10-11am), then will be reopened immediately afterwards. Clarke St. will be closed 8:30am-noon.

**Remembrance Day** is commemorated on November 11th each year and marks the end of World War I in 1918. It may also be commonly known as **Armistice Day**.

The intention of the day is to remember the fallen on both sides in the Great War (first world war).
