The 3hr Adjacent Rule

Section 6.3.5. states:

No person shall park a motor vehicle adjacent to the residential property of another person, upon any highway within the City for a period of more than three hours.

- Unique to Port Moody
- Adjacent to single or semi-detached homes only
- Enforced only on complaint by resident
- Often disputed because no posted signage

Commuter Parking in Residential Neighbourhoods



- Effective to discourage commuter parking
- Disputed first offence adjusted to a warning
- Staff working with residents most effected

Proposed Change

No person shall park a motor vehicle adjacent to the residential property of another person, upon any highway within the City for a period of more than three hours, **between the hours of 7am and 7pm, Monday to Friday.**
